English

The children will be taking part in daily handwriting, grammar, spelling and punctuation activities.

The children will have opportunities to write: character descriptions, diary entries, recounts, narratives and fact-files through our key texts. These are: The First Drawing; Stone Age Boy and Book of Bones.




Maths

This term we will be focussing on the following areas of the mathematics curriculum:

Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division and more Place Value.

The children will use reasoning and problem solving skills through all of these key concepts. I have uploaded lots of games to the class website page to support these topics at home.



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Science

The children will learn about the right types of nutrition and what different foods they can get this from. They will also discover the names of the bones in the skeleton and how our muscles work.



Religious Education

Family: Homes

During this topic the children will: explore what being a family means; God's vision for every family; how families show love and respect; learn about The Holy Family; how prayers help us feel closer to God; Jesus' love and that they have been chosen to be part of God's family.



Home Learning

There is no formal home learning being set for your children. However, they will be expected to read aloud to someone at home each evening. A little bit of Spelling Shed and Times Tables Rockstars would also be hugely beneficial.



Computing

The children will have a session with Mrs Morely on a Tuesday afternoon and they will be learning about coding. They will have the opportunity to design, write and debug programs.



PE

This term our PE lessons will teach the children about fitness and lots of athletics skills.

PE kits need to be labelled and in school every day.

Design and Technology

The children will be using the Stone Age to inspire some learning around the seasonality of food. We will then prepare some dishes that use some of the cooking techniques they would have used way back then. The children will also learn about cave paintings and have a go at creating some of their own.



RSE

The children will learn that mental wellbeing is a part of daily life and some ways in which they can look after their mental health. They will understand that there is a range of emotions and these are normal.



History

Green Class will be travelling all the way back to The Stone Age. They will use sources and artefacts to learn all about how the world used to be. They will learn how they lived, cooked, hunted and evolved into The Bronze Age.
