

- If you wish you can try the activity (although this is quite a lot of maths today!)

Phonics:

You can practise *all* the sounds for Year 1 here: see PowerPoint of Year 1 phonemes (sounds): <https://www.stmarysrc.e-sussex.sch.uk/orange-class-at-home> on St Mary's website

- A phoneme is a single spoken sound
- A grapheme is the written down form of that single sound
- A digraph is when 2 letters make one sound for example: 'sh' or 'oa'

- Today's sound is the long /ai/ sound
- How do we make this sound?
- ai, ay, a-e

- See if you can read the little story below and spot all the different /ai/ words
- See if you can write all the /ai/ words from the pictures on the attached sheet (you don't need to print it, you can write the words on paper if you wish or sound them out loud)
- Don't look at the answers on the second sheet until you've had a try!

Please see the attached picture sheet: 'After Easter'

Here is a little reminder of all the things that happened after that first Easter Sunday – the day that Jesus came alive again or *rose from the dead*.

We call Jesus coming alive again his *Resurrection*.

- Look at the pictures on the sheet.
- If you have a Bible, you might find some of these stories in your Bible too.

- The first picture shows Mary of Magdalene (Martha and Lazarus's sister, the bad Mary who wiped Jesus's feet with her hair).
- Mary goes to the garden very early in the morning, three days after Jesus died on the cross.
- She goes to visit his tomb and leave some flowers.
- In the garden she meets the risen Jesus.

- The second set of pictures shows Jesus appearing to his disciples for the first time after his resurrection.
- Thomas is not there and doesn't believe Jesus is alive.
- Jesus appears later and asks Thomas to come and touch him.
- Thomas says 'My Lord and my God!'

- In the next pictures the disciples have been fishing but caught nothing.
- A man on the beach tells them to throw out their nets again.
- They make a huge catch.
- The man on the beach is Jesus, cooking breakfast.

Now think back to today's Gospel Assembly. Watch the video or read the story again. Think about what Jesus means *to you* when he says '*I am the Way the Truth and the Life.*'

Go somewhere quiet, maybe put on some quiet music and draw or write your ideas like we do when we do Lectio Divina in school.
