No one wanted to by the house. It was breaking peacefully and crumbling slowly. The shingles fell off and the roof leaked. Tiny trees sprouted in the gutters.

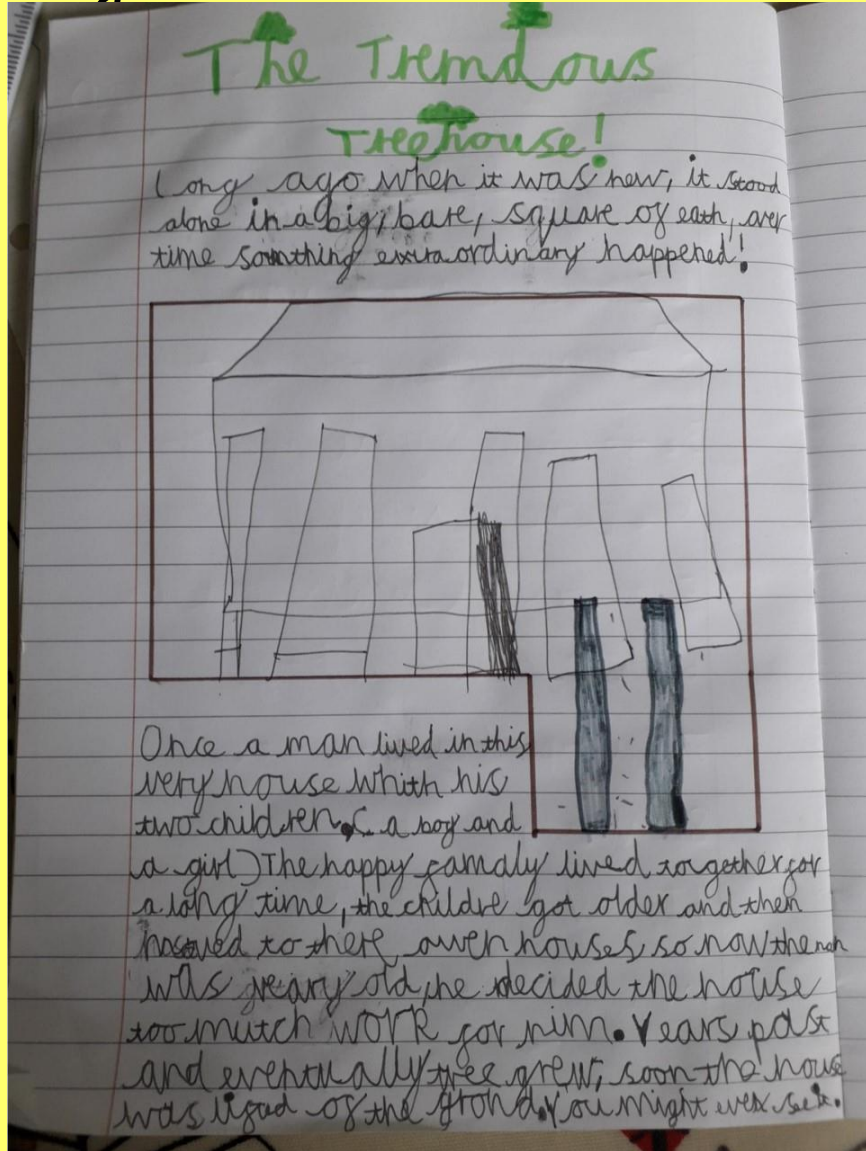
Small saplings grew into strong trees. The trees were growing amazingly and lifted the house off its foundations into the air it floats above the ground and is held up by trees strength.

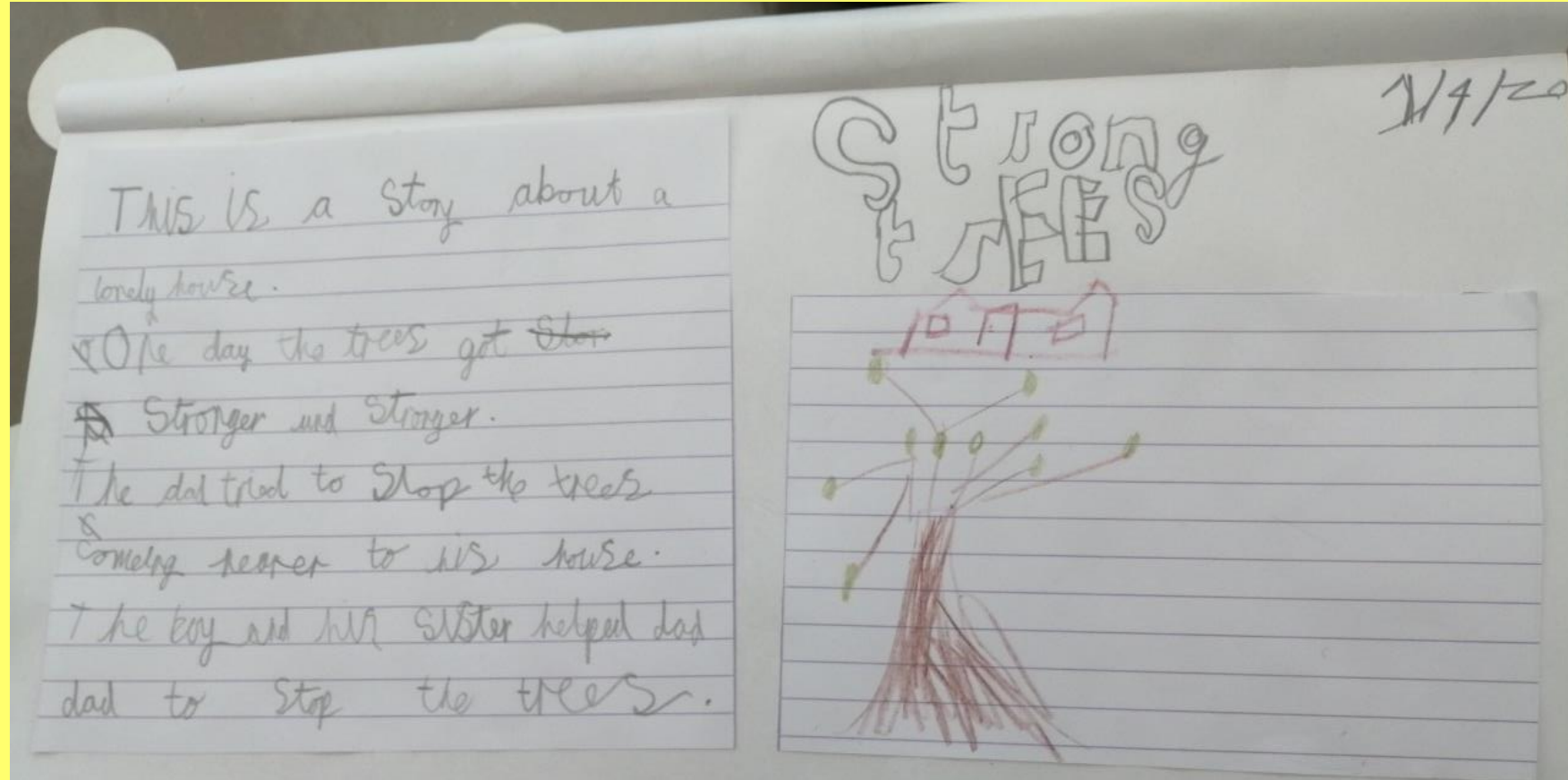

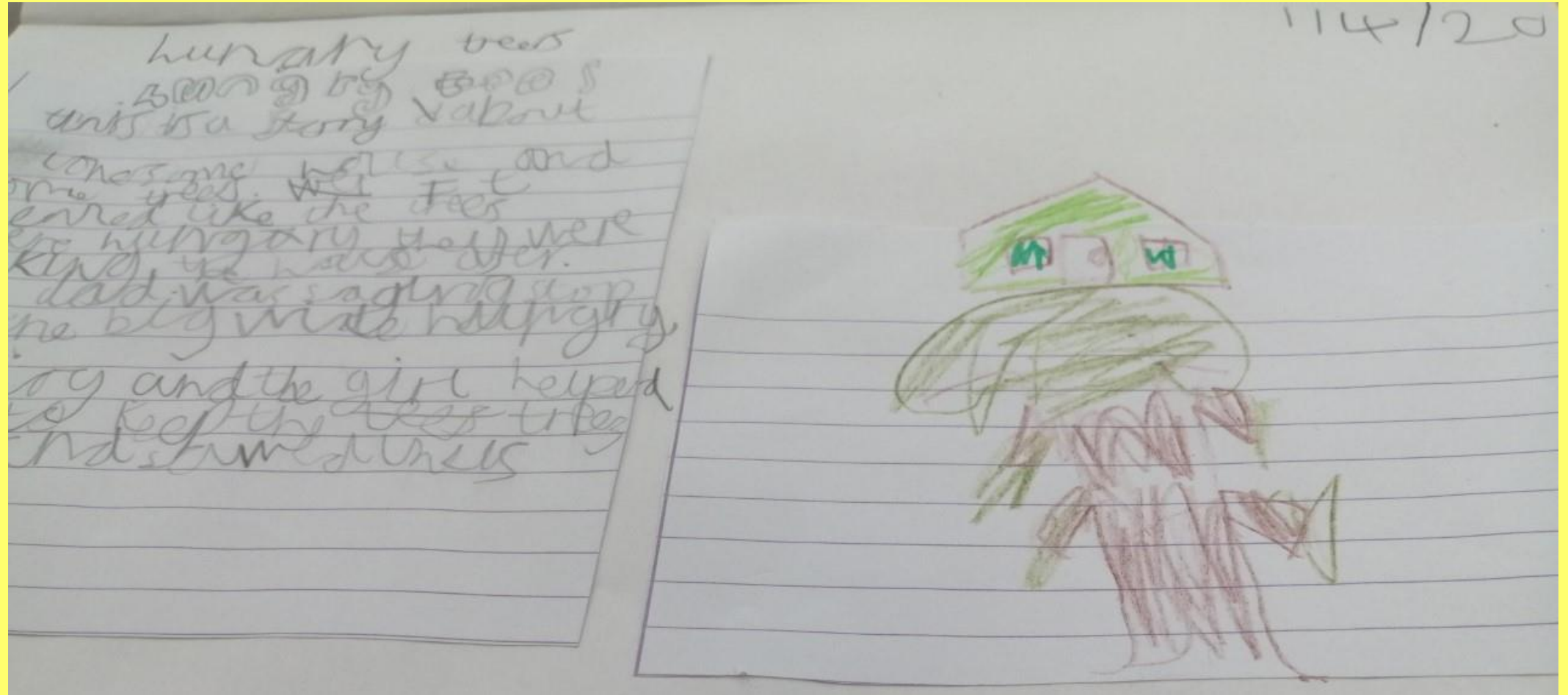

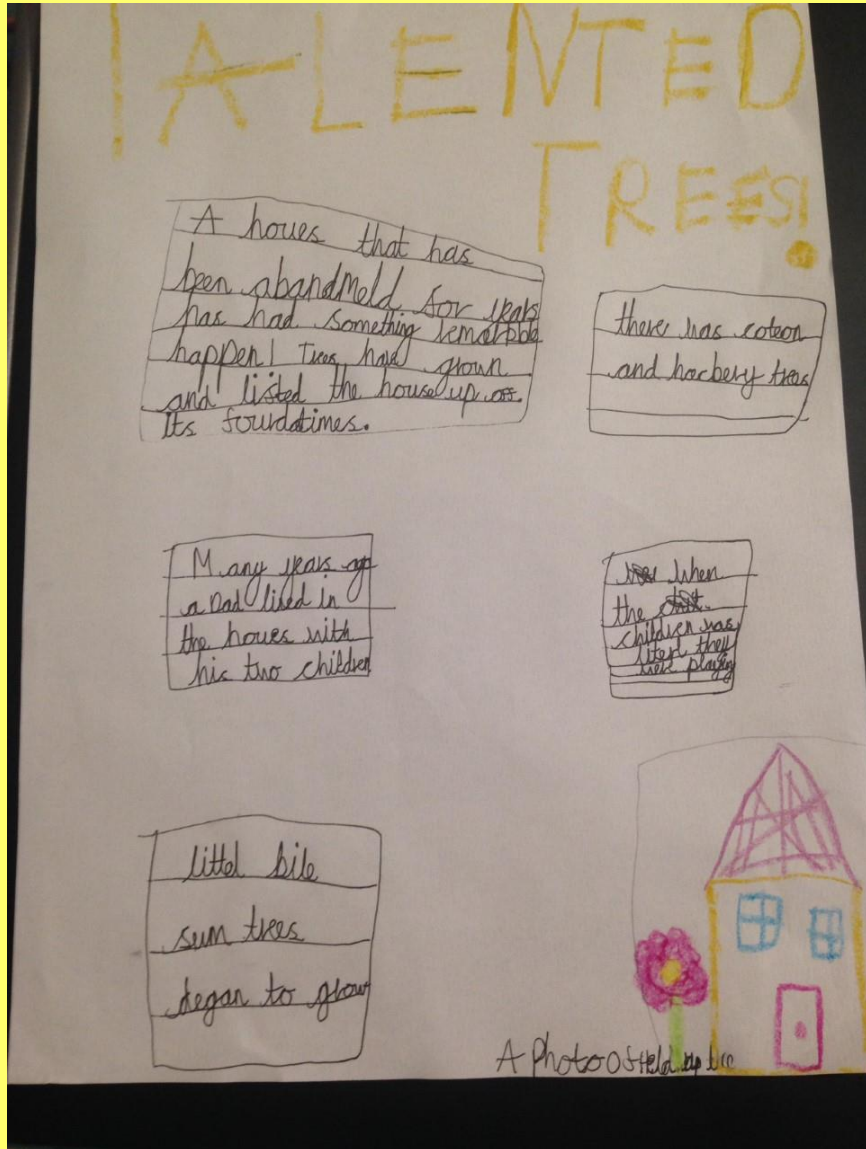
Yesterday I saw a ghostly house! I was shocked to see a house held up by trees. It was basically suspended in mid air.



Many years ago, a man tried to sell this house. But nobody wanted to buy it, and nobody knows why! It was still all around the house.

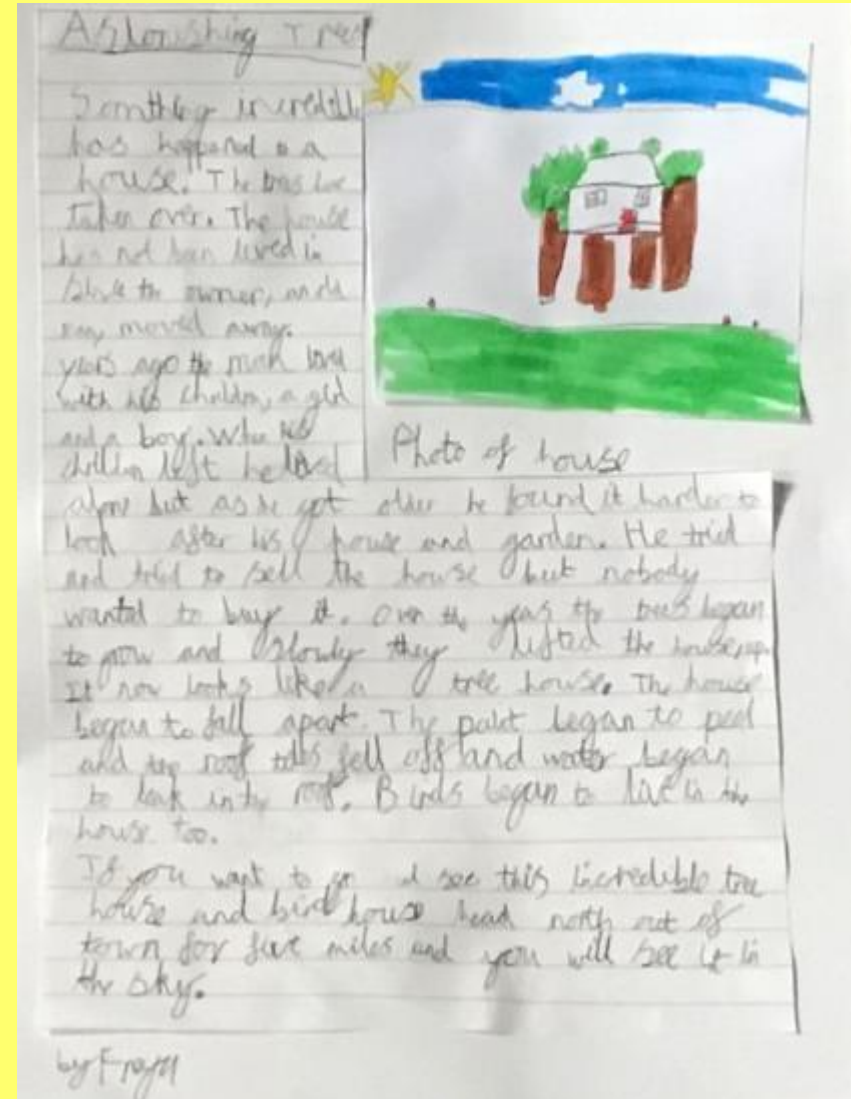
The trees lifted the house up into the air. Now the house is a magnificent sight to behold!

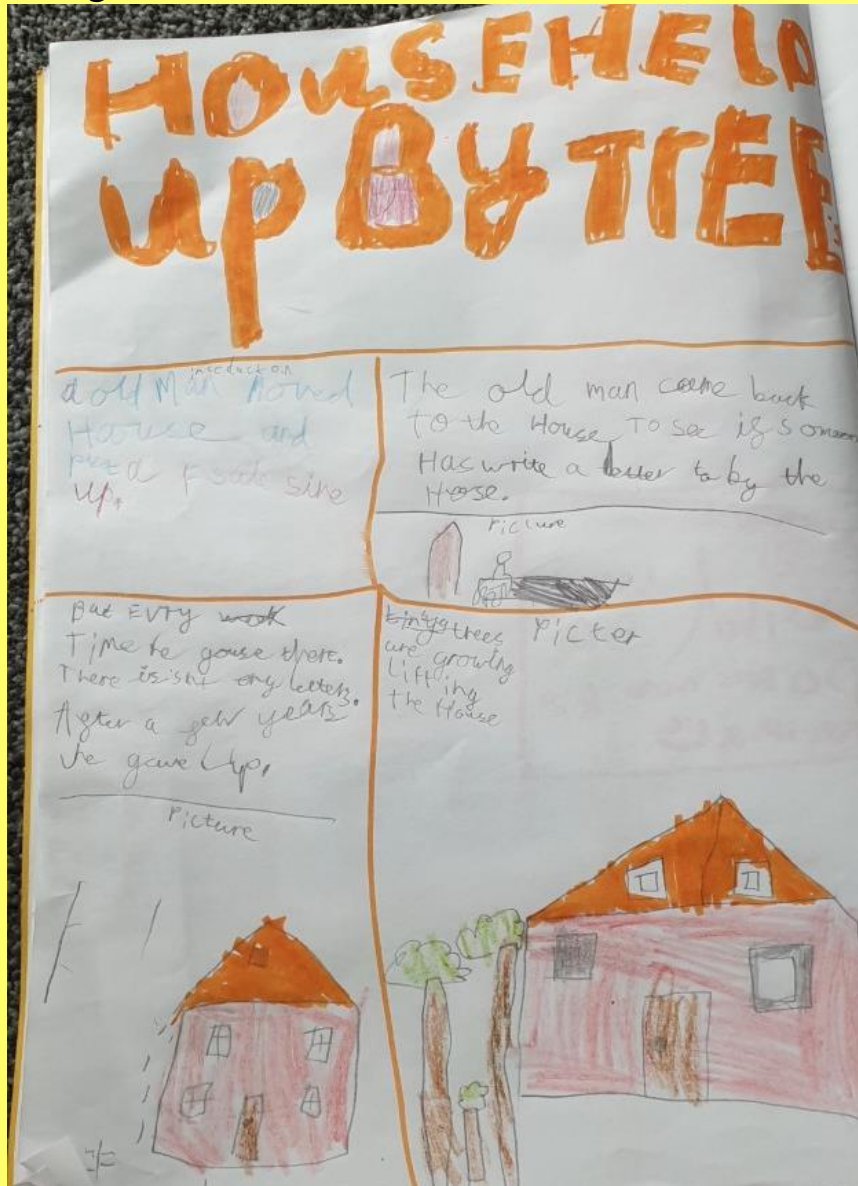

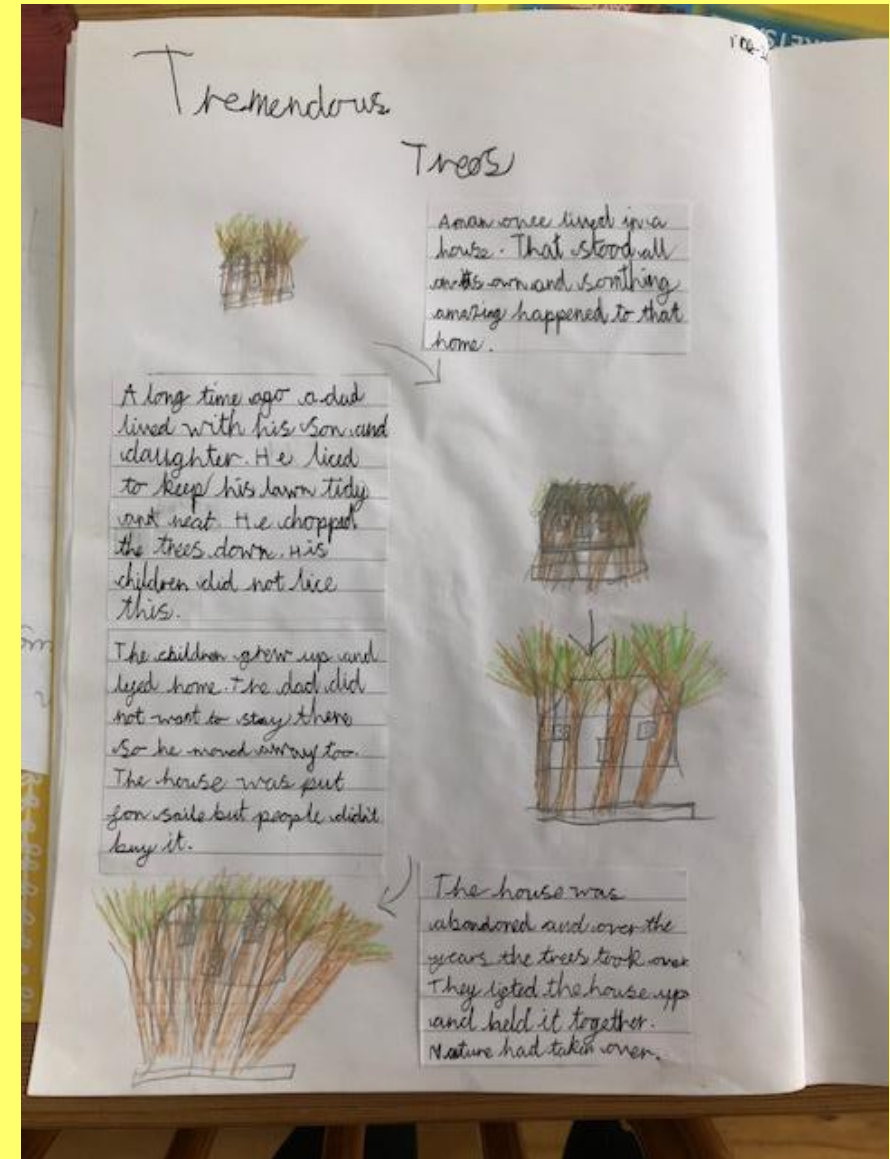

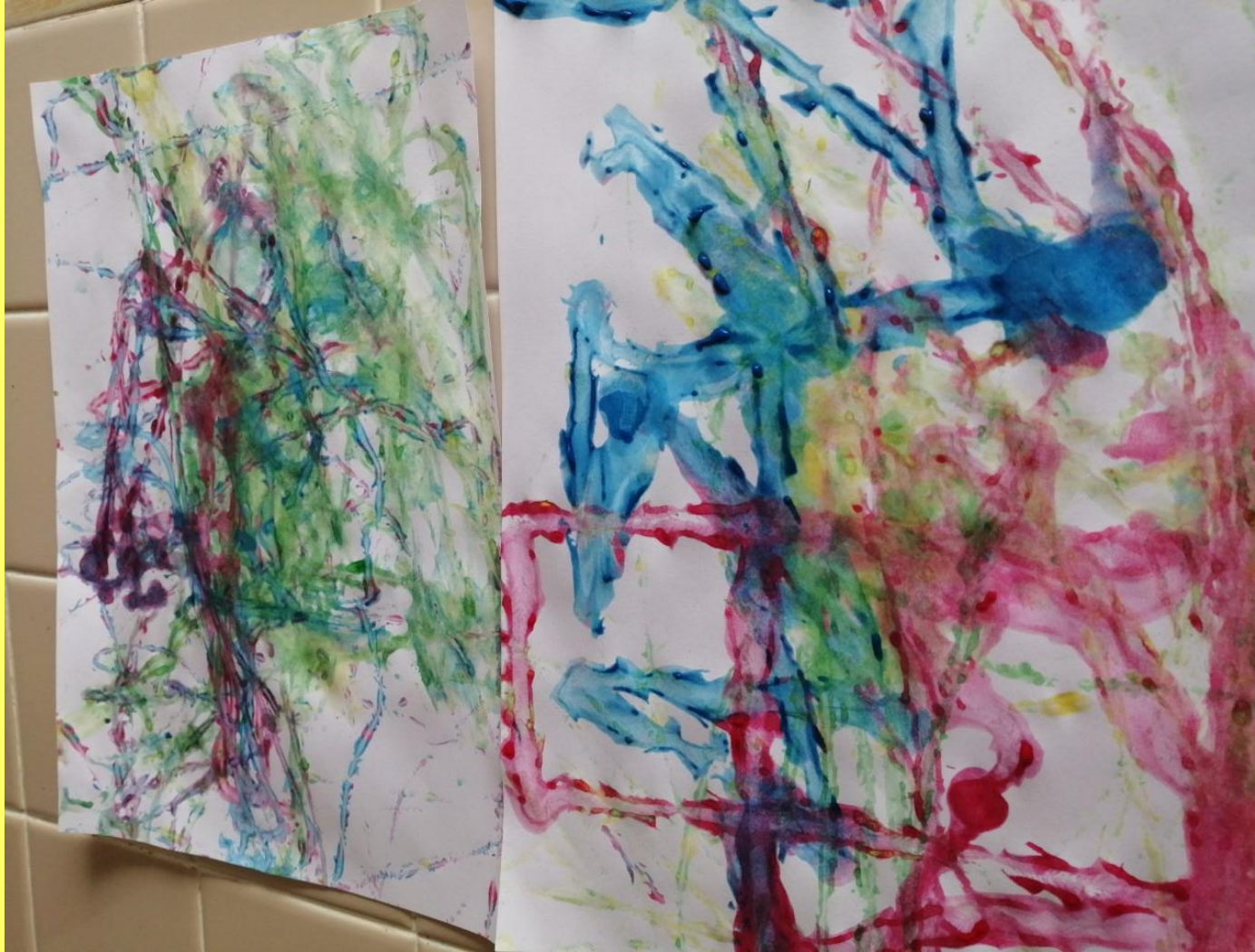
