5. Last! The last stage is the adult salamander.



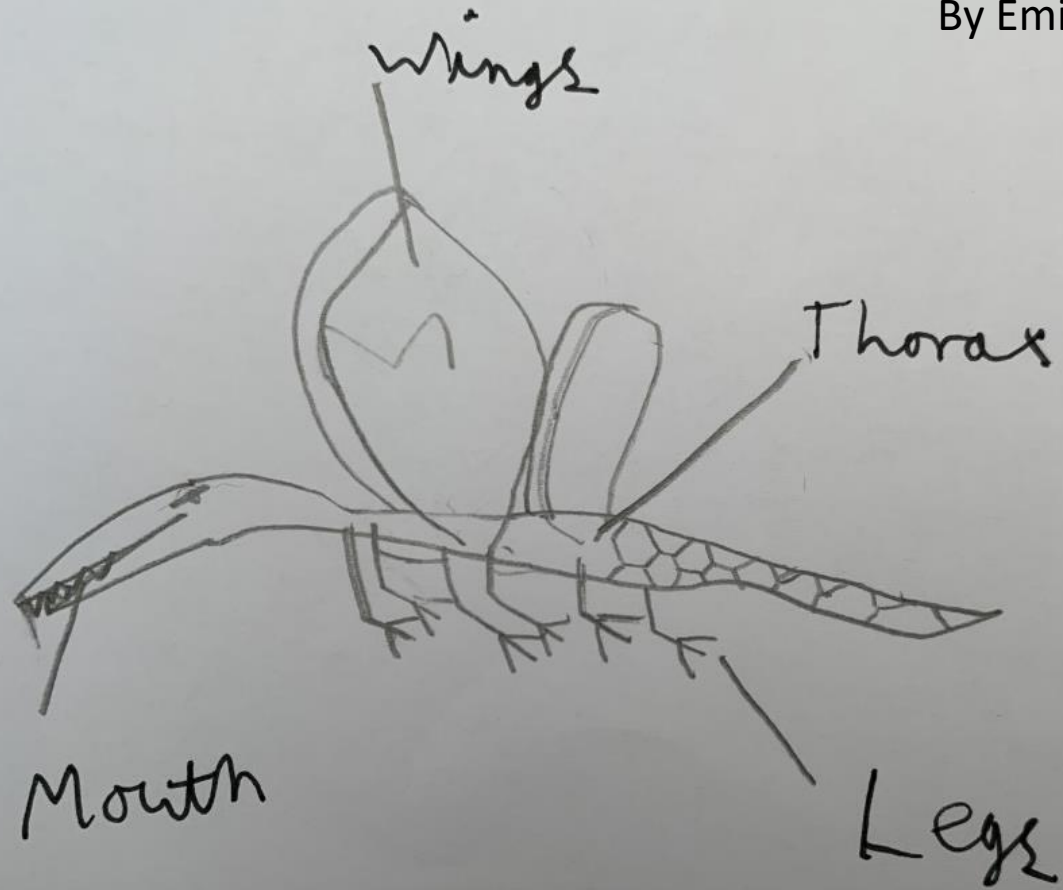
Facts

They have an appearance as a slender body, blunt snout, short limbs and mottled feet. Found in the eastern United States.

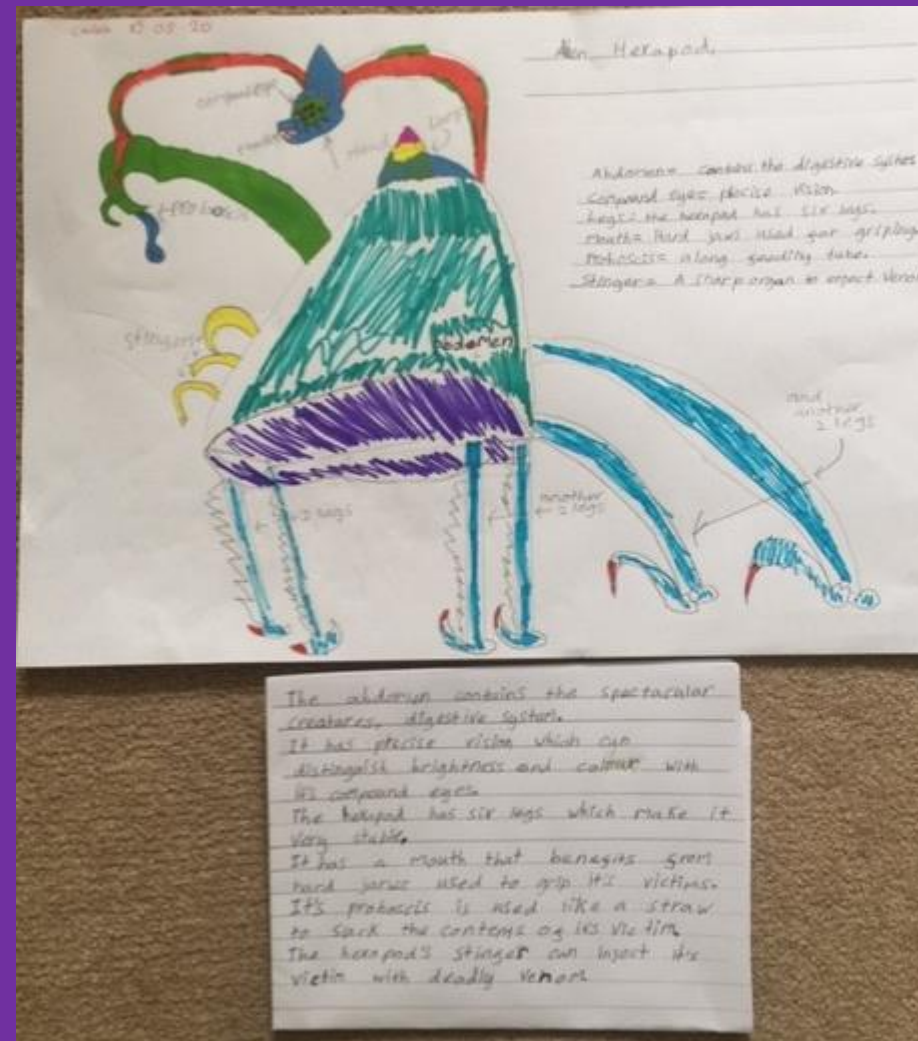

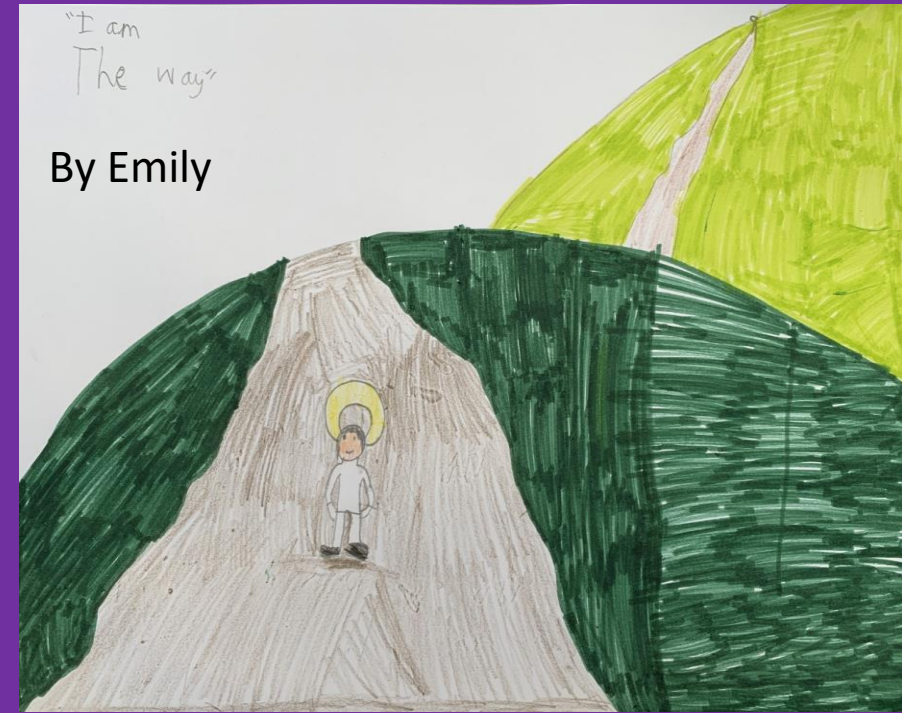
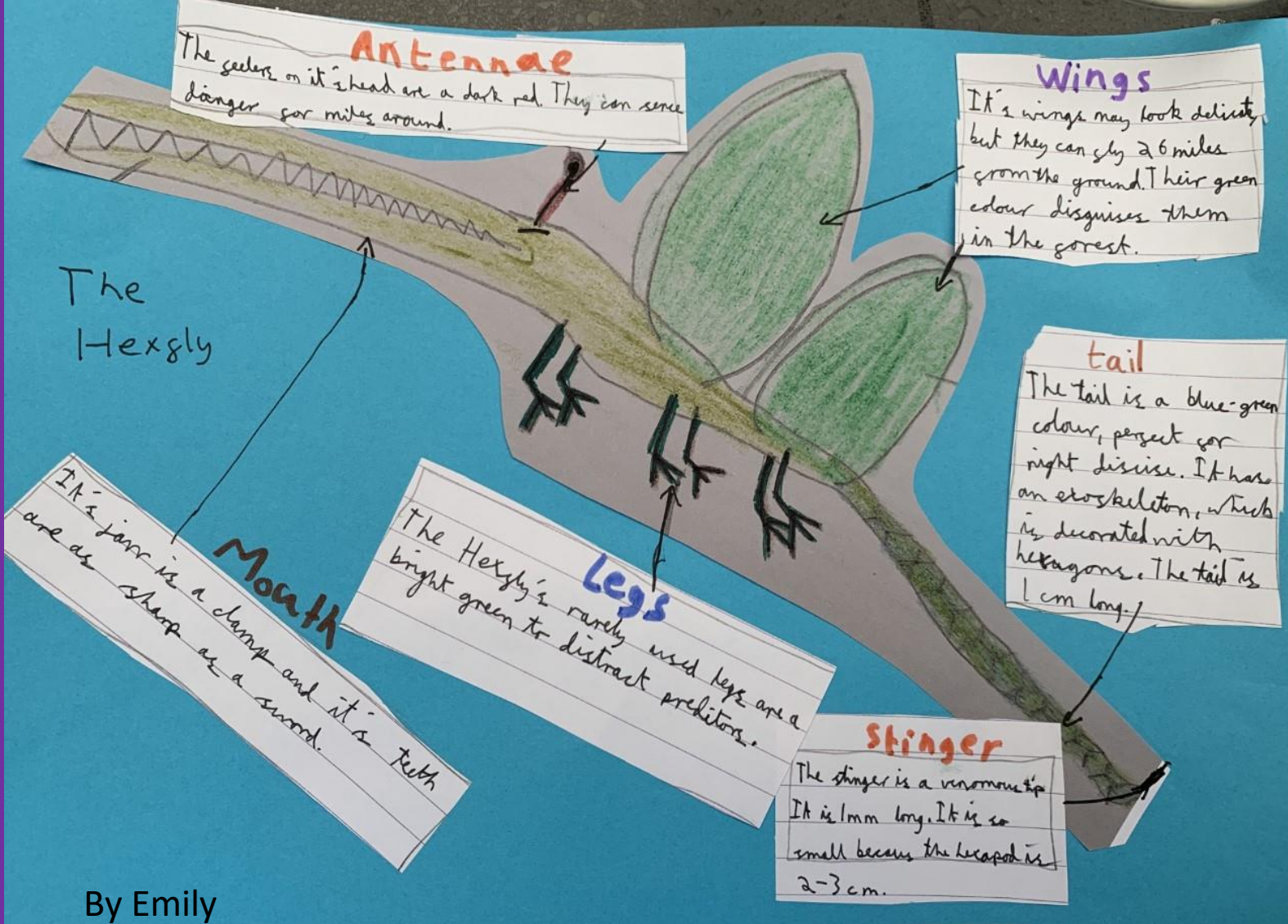

"I tell you truly, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.

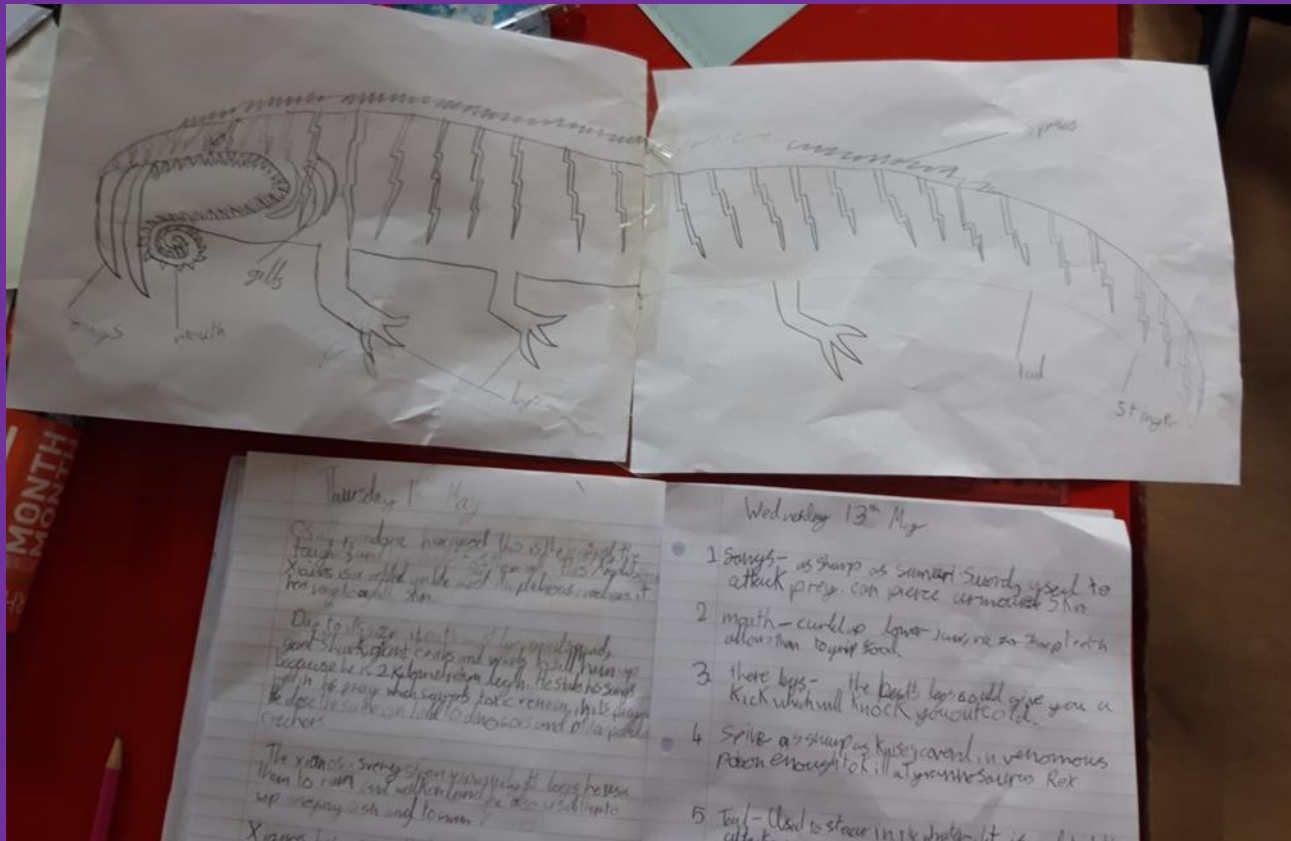
