This term will be thinking about giving as part of Lent and the Easter story after our Eucharist topic.

Science and D&T

Science will consist of electricity this term. Children will be thinking about circuits and symbols and thinking about how different elements to a circuit affect its power.

Computing

Computing skills will be taught by Miss Morely this term. She will be working closely with Miss Ticehurst in these sessions to improve computing skills. We will also try to use a range of multimedia and ICT in as many other subjects as possible.

Home learning

Maths home learning will be set every Tuesday and will be expected to be returned by the next Monday or Tuesday at the latest. This will be either in the form of written work or MyMaths online learning.

English homework will not be set every week, but when appropriate as an introduction to the next task or a consolidation of the week's learning to ensure that it is meaningful to the children.

Spelling will not be in the form of lists learned this year, but the children will bring home personalised words or spelling rules that they have targeted for their own development.

Maths

Within maths sets we strive to ensure that the children have a deeper understanding of the mathematics that they are expected to use by the end of Key Stage 2. Children should be able to use and apply their mathematical learning to a range of real life contexts so that they develop skills for life.

As SATs approach, we will be revisiting a number of key mathematical areas, as well as looking at ratio and proportion. Please ensure your child can recall a range of mathematical knowledge and facts at speed including all multiplication facts up to 12 x 12 and the corresponding division facts. Art

This term our art will centre around the work of Paul Nash and his work as a wartime artist. Children will be particularly examining the hidden messages and subtle changes in his images.
