WEEKLY

Reading:

Children should be reading out loud to someone at home **at least 3 times a week**. In addition an activity should be completed to being monitored in school and the children spelling test. will be rewarded for their efforts.

Spelling:

Spellings may be set each week for children to practice rules and structures at home. This will be assessed in their writing and will not ensure understanding of the text. This is necessarily be assessed with a weekly

Maths:

Pupils must learn multiplication tables (up to 12 x 12). They should be practising their tables and the corresponding division facts every day. 'Hit The Button' and TTRS are great toots for practising at home.
