

Violet Class' Home Learning Wednesday 25th March 2020

These tasks have been designed to help you 'structure' your day. You and your parents have to work together to decide which tasks are non-negotiable and which are not. I am excited to see all the learning that is taking place in your house and look forward to seeing all of your work!

Session One	<p>PE with Joe Wicks 30 min session at 9am! Go along to The Body Coach's You Tube channel and join in with me!</p> <p>Make sure you have had suitable clothing and breakfast first!</p> <p>Tip: if you have SkyQ or a Chromecast device, you can use the TV screen!</p>
Session Two	<p>Maths – Five minute test. Time yourself. Answer these ten questions and time yourself for 5 minutes. Write your answers in the front of your yellow book with the date and tomorrow I will send out the answers your daily lessons for you to green pen.</p> <p>Now check out MyMaths for your maths group's online lesson and task.</p> <p>To finish your maths lesson, please log onto Times Tables Rockstars for ten minutes and work through your garage mode. When you have finished, why not take part in your Battle of the Bands against Indigo Class? We can win this Violet Class!</p>
Session Three	<p>https://vimeo.com/200936986</p> <p>English - Watch yesterday's video again. Now look at the Private Peaceful extract that has been sent to you. Can you read it through and think about the way that the author has built the tension? Has he used repetition? Or varied sentence length?</p> <p>It is now your job to write the war flashback of your character from The Piano. You need to set yourself a 15 minute timer and write for that length of time. Use the clouds of words, the extract and your past writing to help you in this task.</p> <p>When the 15 minutes are up, I want you to read your writing aloud – either to yourself or someone else in the house.</p> <p>Make any initial corrections you want to and then leave the writing to edit tomorrow.</p>
Session Four	<p>History –</p> <p>Violet Class, you may need your parents for this one if you would like to join in with the rest of the nation at 1pm! At this time, Western Approaches HQ- The Battle of the Atlantic Experience will be using their Facebook page to live stream a history lesson based on life in Wartime Liverpool. This is hosted by a qualified teacher and will include a tour of the museum. If you cannot watch on Facebook, it is my understanding that they will be adding a video of this to their YouTube channel (Western Approaches) later on.</p> <p>You do not, however, have to use this resource to complete your history task. You could use research to carry out a study of another British city in war time.</p> <p>Using whichever resources you have chosen, I would like you to show me what you know about living in the city during war time. This could look like a series of diary entries; a fact file; a double page spread report or any other method of presenting your information.</p> <p>You could include details about air raids, rationing, evacuation and jobs people did.</p>

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	<p>This should take at least two lessons to complete and you may want to draft your information before you finally present it. Don't panic if this isn't finished today!</p> <p>If you want to send me photos of work unfinished to help you edit, that is fine!</p>
Session Five	<p>Project time:</p> <p>I would like you to pick one of the Year 6 tasks from your sheet, which went home with you in your folder last week.</p> <p>I would like you to select one which sparks your interest – you have my permission to adapt a task to suit you. The catch is that you must make this a proper project. It will take more than one session. This means: taking your time; doing your research; editing carefully; thinking about your presentation and being ready to show me what you came up with at the end of the week! So make sure you select a task that will fulfil your brief and be as creative as you like!</p>
