Home Learning Grid ~ Year 4 Term 2

WEEKLY Home learning will be due in on the Wednesday of each week.

Reading:

Children should be reading out loud to someone at home **at least 3 times a week**. In addition, a reading activity to be completed weekly. This is being monitored in school and the children will be rewarded for their efforts.

Spelling:

Spellings may be set each week for children to practice rules and structures at home. This will be assessed in their writing and will not necessarily be assessed with a weekly spelling test.

Maths:

Pupils must learn multiplication tables (up to 12×12). They should be practising their tables and the corresponding division facts **every day**. 'Hit The Button', Timestables Rockstars and MyMaths are great tools for practising at home.

You may decide how you will respond to the tasks set; some may be presented using a computer, others may take the form of a piece of art, 3D art, cookery, textile work, etc. **The possibilities are endless.**

Find out about the types of shield used in the Battle of Hastings. Make a model for your own shield.

Research castles or forts, design your own castle. You could present this in whatever way you like.

Make up a battle site, draw a map and the soldiers. Highlight all the advantages and disadvantages of the grounds.

At least two panels of the Bayeux tapestry went missing. These would have shown Williams coronation. Draw what these two panels would have looked like.

Write a diary entry as if you were King Harold in the days leading up to the Battle of Hastings. How is he feeling and what is he thinking?

Create a presentation with facts about 1066 to share with the class.
